



Visiting Hours

Suggested Visting Hours are 11 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. Any adult or child visitor should be in good health and free of respiratory infections or other communicable diseases.

Limiting the number and length of time visitors stay provides the patient with a more restful recovery. Visitors are asked not to sit or lie on the patient beds or on the unoccupied bed nor should they use either bed for personal articles such as purses, coats, etc.

Children visitors: When children visit they are requested to stay in the patient's room under adult supervision.

Clergy may visit anyone at anytime, with patient and/or family permission.

Obstetrics/Nursery: Any visitor or relative who will be in contact with a newborn, please check at the nurses desk prior to visiting.

High Observation Care: Family members may have ten minute visits every hour, subject to the patient's condition. Please check with a nurse for possible exceptions.
