

Sleepy Eye Medical Center 2020 Charges for Top 25 Procedures

Minnesota law requires primary care clinics to annually post information about the 25 most frequent services they provide that cost more than \$25. The law requires clinics to post their charges, expected payment rate from Medicare and Medicaid, and average amount paid by commercial insurance companies.

Attention: The amounts posted below DO NOT reflect the amount(s) each clinic patient will pay for the services listed. For specific information about the amount you will owe for the services you receive, please contact your insurance company by calling the number listed on your insurance card. The charges represent the standard amount Sleepy Eye Medical Center Bills for any service. Most often, charges are not the amount the clinic actually gets paid for the service. For most patients, clinics are paid at a level well below these charges.
